Big Walleye: Optional big walleye pot
of \$20, 100% of pot goes to the big-
gest walleye.

Big Northern: Optional big northern
pot of \$20, 100% of the pot goes to
the biggest northern.

Big Perch: Optional big perch pot of
\$20, 100% of the pot goes to the big-
gest perch.

Contingencies: 3rd place will receive
a free TOY entry into our 2018 sea-
son; valued at \$150. Not refundable
and no cash value.

Rules 2017 – REV A

- Eligibility:** 2017 TOY teams will be invited to the Fall Event. You can have 2 or 3 people on your team, but at least one member must be a TOY member from 2017. Kids under age 17 fish for free but number of fishers per boat cannot exceed the boat manufacturers recommendation. Maximum of 3 people per boat can be age 18 and over. We will offer 19 spots to TOY teams first, and if there are open spots, we may allow other teams in, not to exceed 19 teams. The minimum number of teams will be 10, if we don't have 10 we will refund entries. Deadline to sign up is September 19, 2017 @ 6PM. After that we will open it up to the general public, with a final deadline to sign up of October 5th, 2017.
- Entry Fee:** \$100/ Team—%100 Payout
- Date:** October 7th, 2017
- Fishing Time:** 8AM – 3PM
- Place:** Indian Springs near Clark, SD
- Boundaries:** All water reachable by boat on designated lake.
- Weather:** Bad weather will result in either the launch being moved or date to be changed to the following day. If we don't fish we will refund entries. Directors have final say.
- Check In:** All boats must check in at the trailer. Inspections will be done by members of the Glacial Lakes Walleye League Event Committee before entering the water.
- Fish:** You can have your possession limit in your boat, but the minimum size is 15" and you can only weigh 5 walleyes with 2 being over 20". Each team is responsible for selecting their own big fish which will be weighed first.
- Weigh In:** Scale will be open at 3pm. Teams must return to weigh in by water. At least 1 team member must report to the weigh-in even if the team does not have a fish to weigh. Boat must be in sight and off plane to be considered on time. Do not leave fish unattended until they are weighed. Official Tournament ruler/scale is the judge. Director's decision is final in the weighing and measuring of fish. Teams deemed late will be disqualified.
- Laws:** ALL STATE LAWS will be adhered to and under no circumstance will GLWL rules trump SDGFP law. Follow the letter of the law at all times. If any of the above rules are broken will be grounds for immediate disqualification.
- Sportsmanship:** All contestants are expected to follow high standards of sportsmanship, courtesy, safety, and conservation. During the tournament no other boats may come in contact with other contestants boats.
- Ties:** In case of a tie, biggest walleye decides, coin flip second.
