

## Mid-Season Event Rules Sheet



3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Midseason Event June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019

- Eligibility:** Everyone is welcome to fish this event
- Entry Fee:** \$200 per team; Max 3 adults per team, children age 17 and under are welcome but cannot exceed boat manufacturer capacity. No more than 6 lines in the water at once. – Maximum of 99 teams.
- \$20 from each team will go to managing the tournament  
**ALL ENTRIES ARE FINAL and NON-REFUNDABLE– No Exceptions**
- Date:** June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019
- App Deadline:** By end of business May 24<sup>th</sup>, 2019. After May 24<sup>th</sup> late fees will apply. All Event Applications must be completed and returned in its entirety. See **GLACIAL LAKES WALLEYE LEAGUE/MIDSEASON EVENT APPLICATION**

- Example: If team 20 leaves at 6:50am, Team 21 will leave as close to team #20 as safety permits.
- Place:** Bitter Lake
- Boundaries:** Any area accessible by boat after launch unless deemed unlawful by South Dakota Law.
- Weather:** Bad Weather will result in either the launch being moved or date to be changed to the following day. Directors have final say.
- Check In:** All boats must check in at the trailer. Inspections will be done by members of the Glacial Lakes Walleye League Midseason Event Committee before entering the water.
- Tagging:** Each fish must be tagged before it goes into your live well. You will receive 7 tags and the best 5 fish (2 over 20") will be weighed. All fish **MUST** be tagged/locked and any unused/unlocked tags must be returned to the scale **UNLOCKED**. No other fish may be in your well.
- Check In:** Scale will be open at 1pm. Teams must return to weigh in by water. We will be using the "Drive up weigh in" process. At least 1 team member must report to the weigh-in and return the numbers packet even if the team does not have a fish to weigh. Boat must be in sight and off plane to be considered on time. Do not leave fish unattended until they are weighed. Official Tournament ruler/scale is the judge. Director's decision is final in the weighing and measuring of fish. Teams deemed late will be disqualified.
- Check Boat:** If you are contacted by a check vessel... **If you have a fish on**, wave both hands in the air till the fish is landed. **If you DO NOT have a fish on** wave 1 hand and the vessel will approach. You **ARE NOT** allowed to enter your live well for any reason while the check boat is approaching "Live Well Diving" is grounds for immediate disqualification.
- Laws:** ALL STATE LAWS will be adhered to and under no circumstance will GLWL rules trump SDGFP law. Follow the letter of the law at all times. Children under age 17 must wear a PFD while on plane at all times. If any of the above rules are broken will be grounds for immediate disqualification.
- Sportsmanship:** All contestants are expected to follow high standards of sportsmanship, courtesy, safety, and conservation. During the tournament, no other boats may come in contact with other contestant's boats. Drunkenness at any official activity will be grounds for disqualification. Ties: In case of a tie, biggest walleye decides, coin flip second.
